## Subutex

Subutex is a discontinued brand of buprenorphine sublingual tablets used to treat opioid dependence. Marketed by Reckitt Benckiser Pharmaceuticals (now Indivior), it was approved by the U.S. Food and Drug Administration in 2002 as part of medication-assisted treatment for opioid use disorder. It remains available under generic names or in other countries.
